




① White side up.




② Blintz.




③ Rabbit-ear each.




⑥ M+F in half.



⑤ Fish base.





b) Squash-fold the four small flaps.




- ⑧ Look inside model and VF the large flap, from the center of the outer edge (X) inward, to lock.



b) Mt. Fold and repeat behind.




- (10) a) Sink hind flap.

- (11) a) Mt-F tail.
b) Push up.
c) Double-rabbit-ear bill, flattening.



(13) MtF. corners of bill



- (12) a) Pinch mt folds in all 4 feet
b) Push in + lift leg (all 4)
c) Push in neck.
