


Use a 10" square paper for the mother echidna, and a 3" square for her baby, which is called a puggle.






② CSU.


③ Blintz.

④ Pinch a flap in half, then pinch the quarter by bringing the half pinch to the folded edge.


⑤ Match up the two pinches, folding halfway between them.




⑧ Rabbit-ear to step 5's crease (side angles not bisected). Repeat on other 3 flaps, & model.



⑨ Arrange the small flaps (feet) as shown above, with the valley crease vertical.
