
Inspired by a small ivory Carving (netsuke) of this lucky god of Japan. I fold this model from a square of parchment-colored calligraphy paper.






Fukurokuju, p. 3




15 Pleat sides to form head and ears.




16 Compound move: Lift beard and fold in order:
1) VF; 2) VF; 3) Push (swivel) so this edge flattens; 4) is a hidden valley fold; 5) Flatten in a mountain fold.




17 Enlarged detail.

angles of the folds.




23 Push up eyes

it.




20 Enl. detail

not to corners.




18 Flip.
