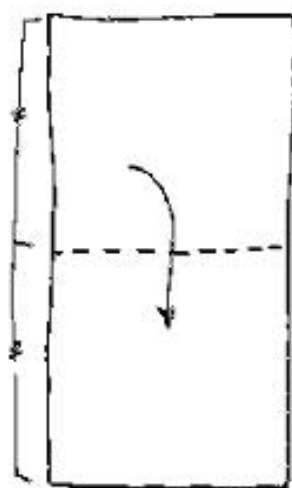


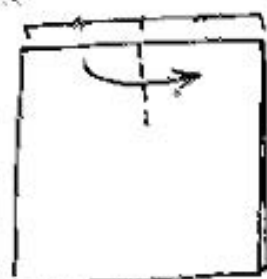
HAPPY AS A CLAM

Start with a square folded or cut in half to yield a 2x1 rectangle. Folding yields a clam same color inside & out; cutting yields a clam different inside and out.

① WSU; VF



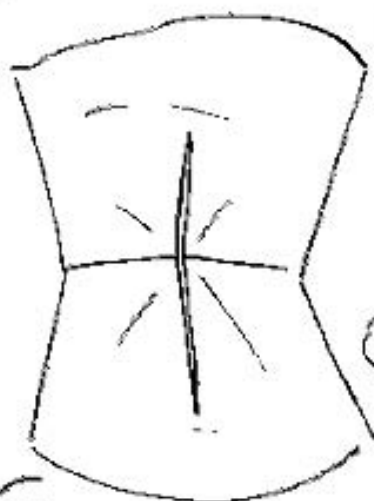
② Fold Sharply.



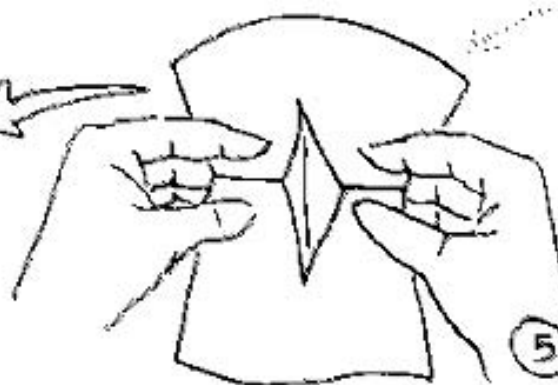
③ Pre-crease sharply, and open T.O.



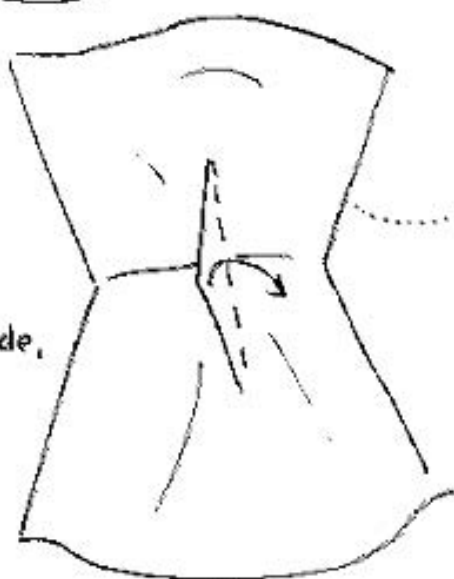
④ Re-fold on the creases as shown & bend the model back.



⑤ Exterior of clam. Turn over



⑤ Hold as shown and pinch the diamond shape together.

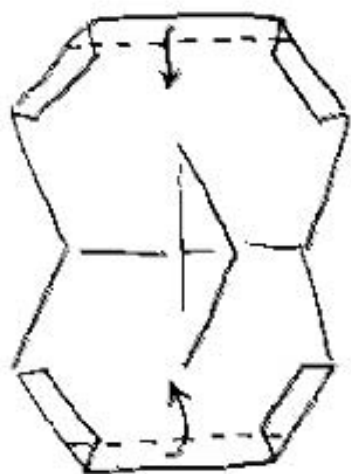


⑦ Fold "dart" to one side, firmly.

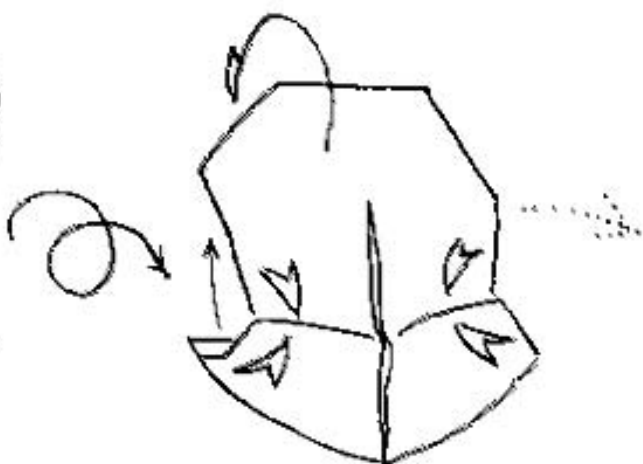


⑧ Blunt upper corners, VF twice. Repeat below, matching upper half.

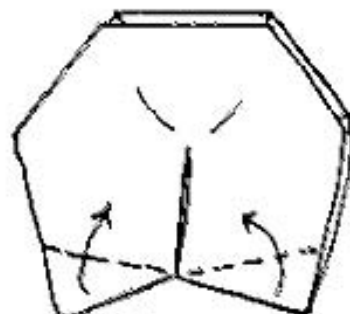

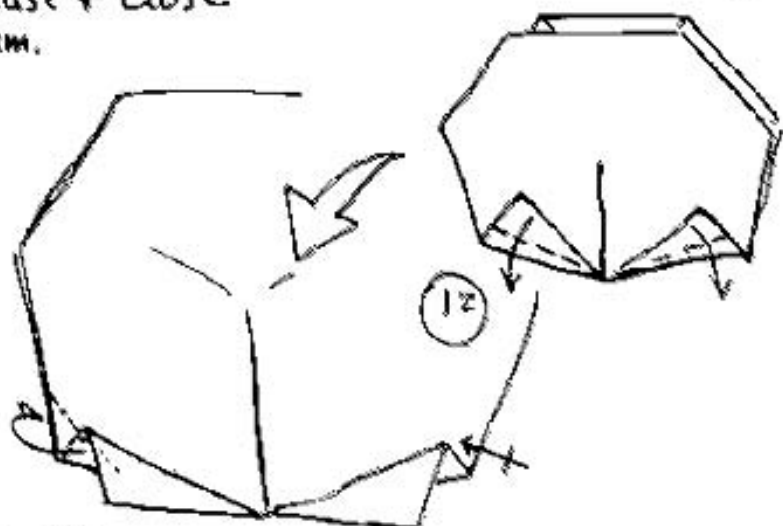
9 VF + T.O.



10 Pinch up horizontal crease + close clam.

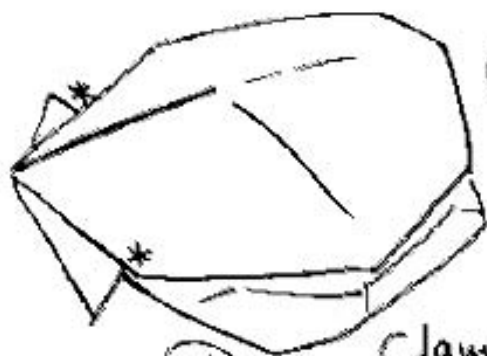

Clam complete. To make clam clap its shell, hold model in one hand and squeeze at *s with the other.

This model looks nice in a half square (2x1) of duo-color paper. Regular Kami results in a white interior.
