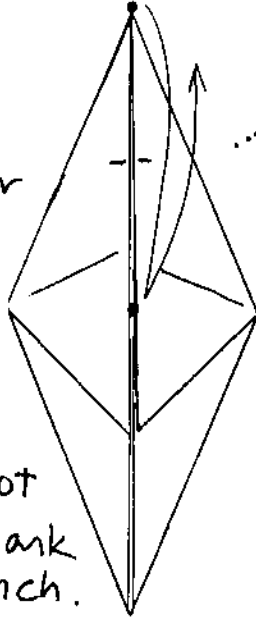
Use two same-size squares (3" for an ATC) folded into fish bases.



I HEAD + FRONT LEGS

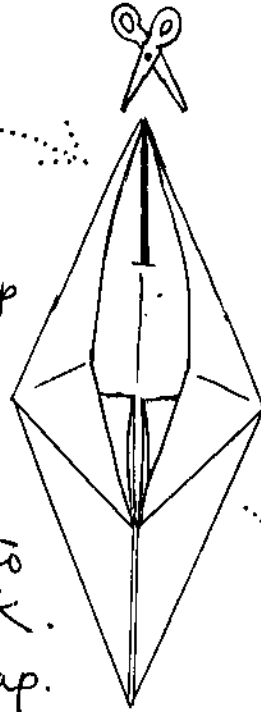

Bring upper long flap of one fish base to mid-point of model (dot to dot). Mark with a pinch.



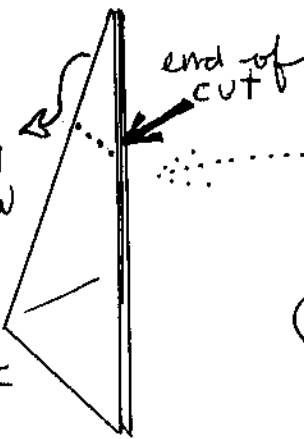

Open flap and cut along mid-line crease from tip to pinch mark. Close flap.



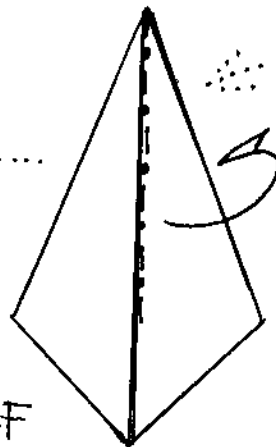

Starting a bit below end of step 2's cut, IRF inner flap to horizontal position.



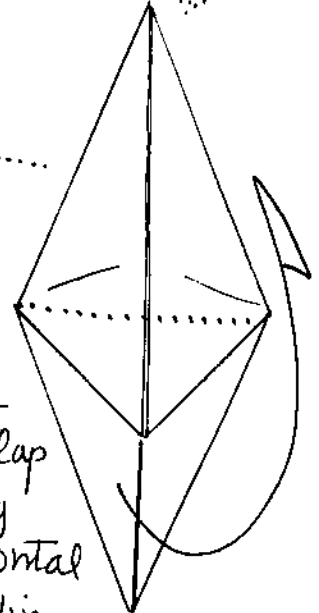

M+F in half vertically.

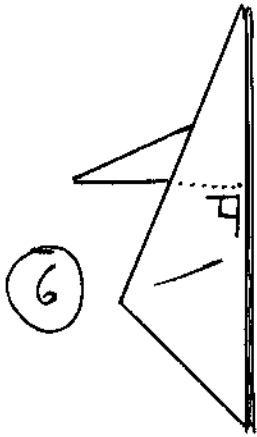

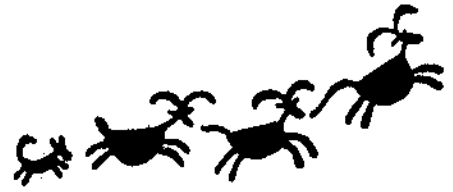
M+F lower long flap along horizontal mid-line.



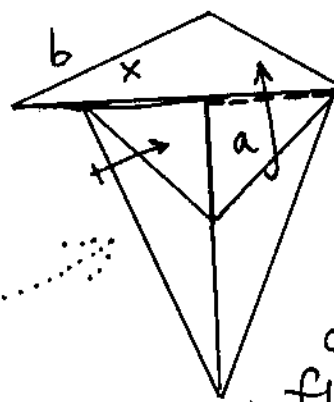
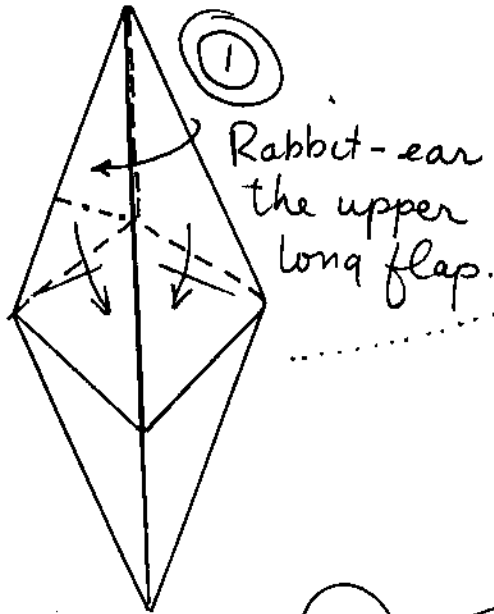
Mountain sheep, p2



Set front half of Sheep aside, to finish after assembly.



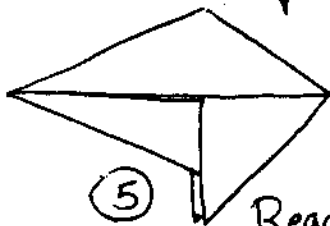
II Body + BACK LEGS - second fish base



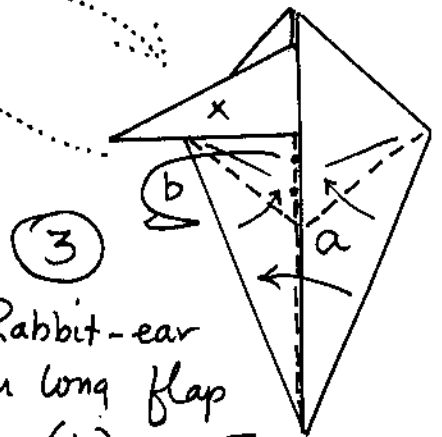
(a) VF small flap on right; (b) Lift up flap X and repeat fold on left-hand small flap. Replace X.



Flip, top to bottom.



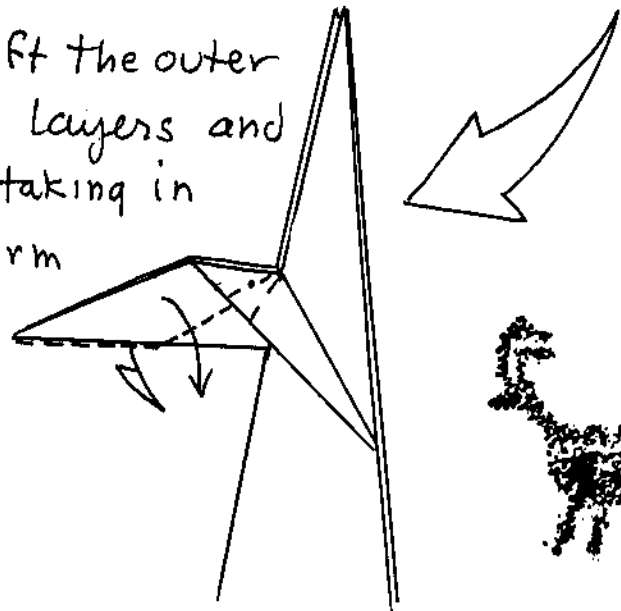
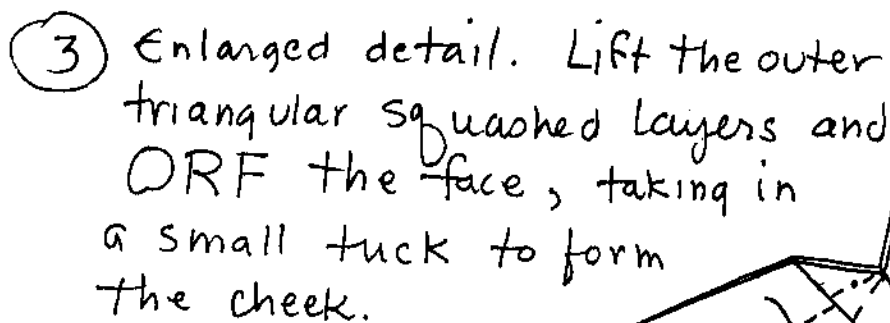
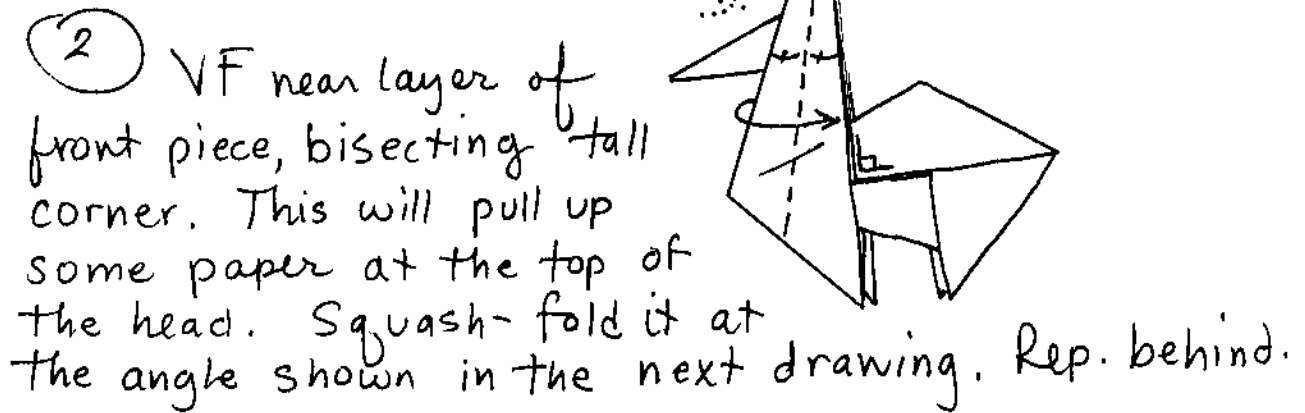
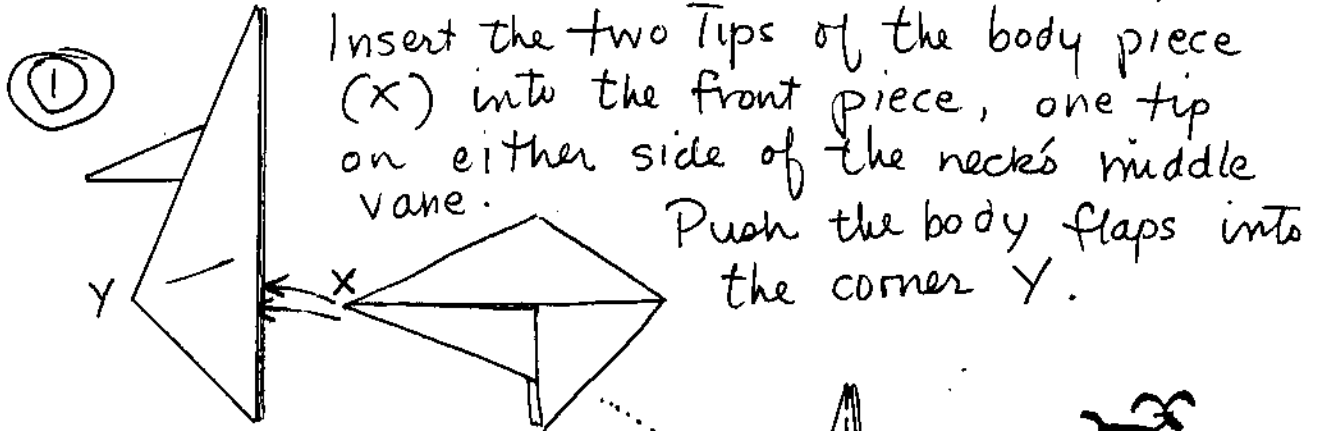
Ready for assembly.



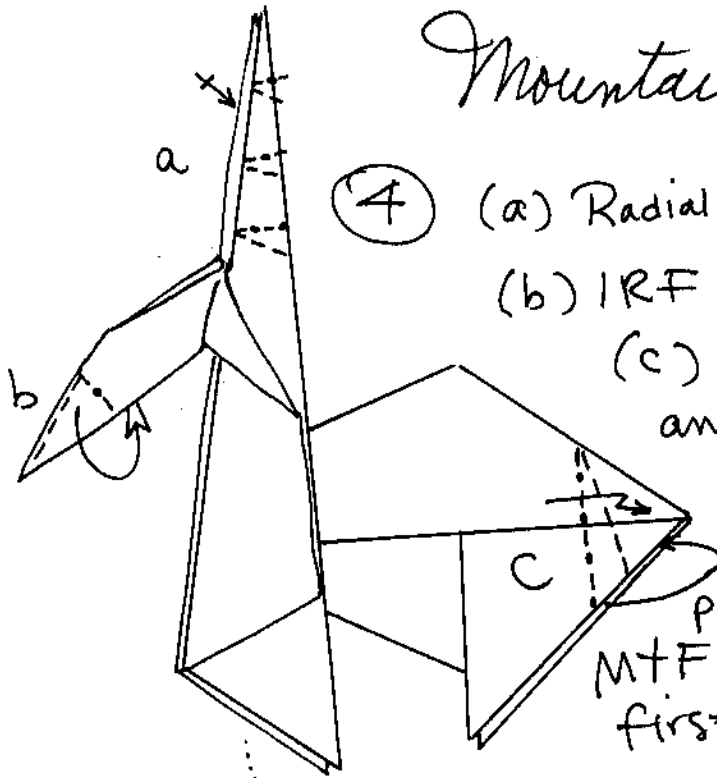
(a) Rabbit-ear lower long flap while (b) M+V left half of paper.

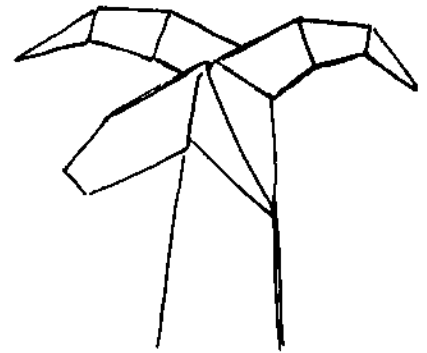
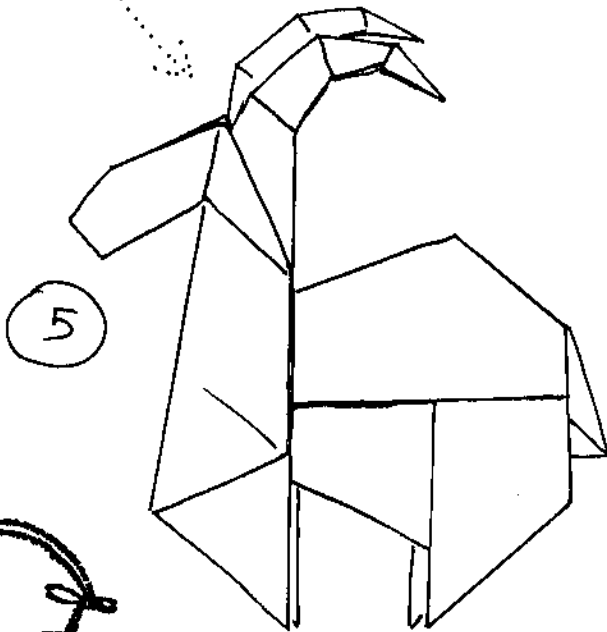
III ASSEMBLY :

 (c) Lift near layer of tail
 and VF far layer so
 its corner meets the
 inside angle. Radial-
 pleat the near layer ;
 MTF it over the far layer
 first.



If desired, pleat
 horns in opposite
 directions, at step
 4 a.
