

a symbol of Kwanzaa


Use a 6" square of duo-color paper in green and yellow. Or use green kami. The corn will be the inner color and the husks green. Start with a preliminary fold, green side out.






8 VF only to middle of flap.




9 VF down the middle of the flap (a) and (b) squash-fold.



10 a) VF near layer. b) DRF tip.



13 VF on right to match step 12's taper.



12 VF - corner D goes past middle of model and a small membrane fold develops on underlying flap. Flatten it.




11 Flip model over left to right.



14 VF top tip and flip model over.



15 Pinch bottom tip in a casual rabbit ear.



Cob is yellow, husk is green.
