

This star starts out with the Christmas tree unit by Rae Cooker in "The Magic of Origami" by Gray & Kasahara.


Use a square of duo-color paper. One color will be underneath but visible. A 10" square yields a 5½" tall star.




① White or under-color up. F-UF books. Flip.




② F-UF diagonals



③ F-UF a blintz flip.




④ IRF the lateral (hidden) flaps.



a) F-UF on left sides 4 times.

b) VF on blintz creases all around.




a) F-UF all around edges.
b) Collapse into a preliminary fold.




⑦ Repeat with the 2 remaining flaps, loosening side flaps to do so.

Note: steps 5 - 9 were traced from Ms. Gray's diagrams.



- 8 Narrow each section of the protruding points, on creases from step 4a:



- 9 Narrow each of the main vanes on the creases from step 5a. Pull tips of main vanes (marked X) up to peak to sharpen small crease marked A-B, + pull remaining tips down.
