

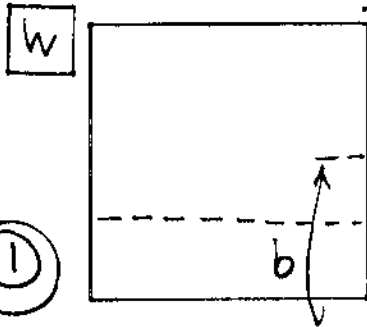


PETRO DOG

Use two squares. For ATCs, a 3" square for the body and a 1 1/2" square for the head. Start white side up.

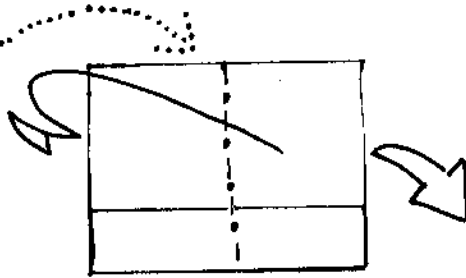

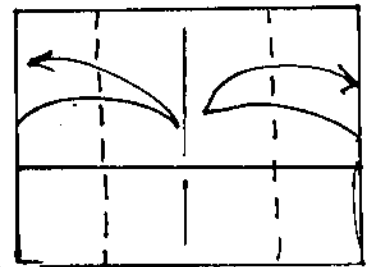

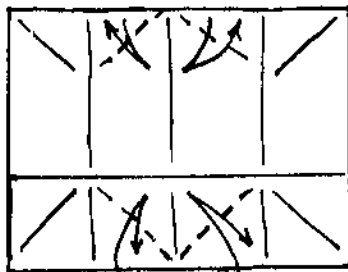
- (a) Pinch the half on the right side of the paper;
 (b) VF lower edge to pinch.



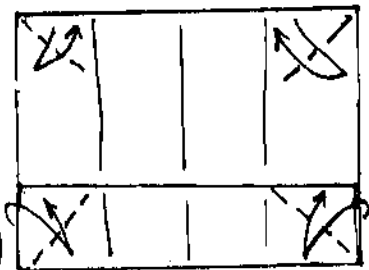
② Mt-FUF in half vertically.



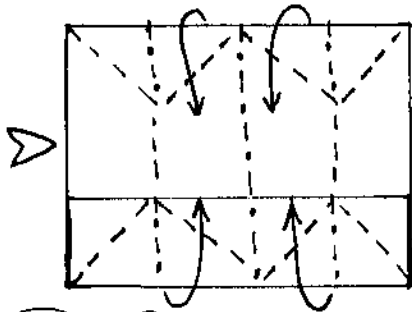
③ Cupboard-FUF.



⑤ FUF a partial blintz-type fold.



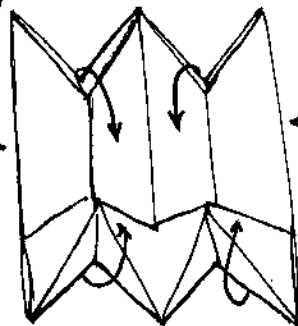
④ FUF partial diagonals.



⑥ Collapse on creases shown.

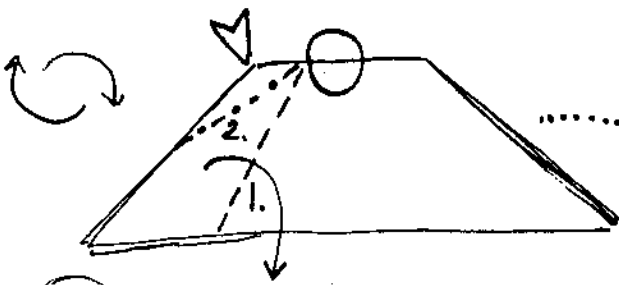

In progress. Flatten (raw edges to the right.)

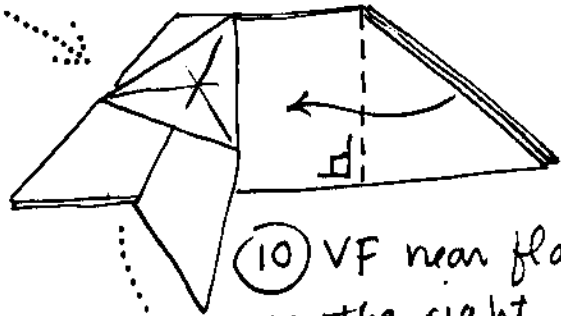


⑧ Tilt 90°.

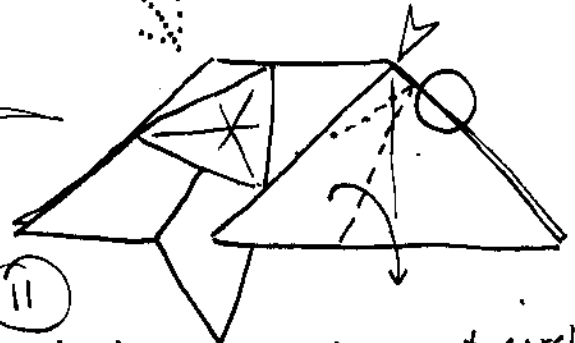




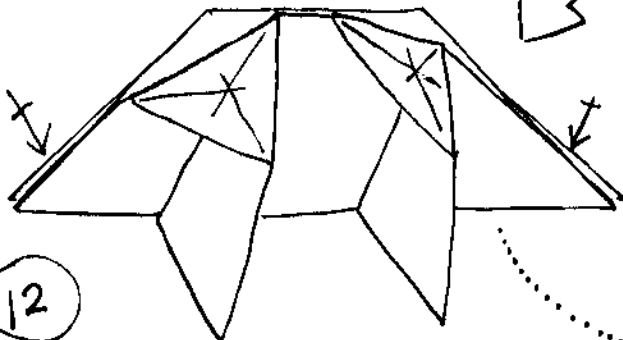
9 Holding paper down at circle, VF at 1. with a triangular spread squash at 2. (Note - thick part of paper is on the left.)



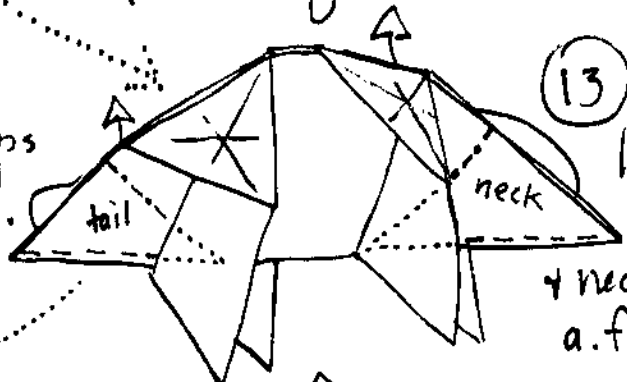
10 VF near flap on the right.



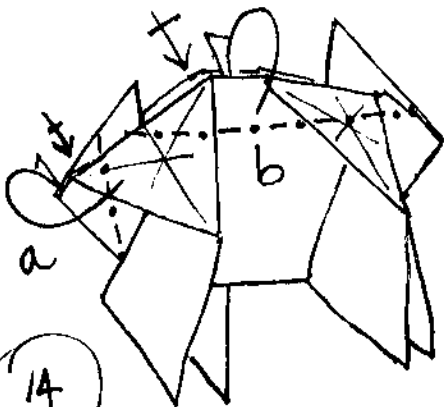
11 Holding paper down at circle, spread-squash as in step 9.



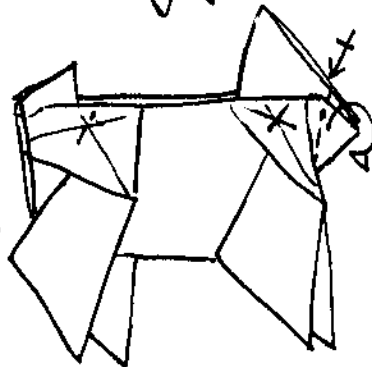
12 Repeat 9-11 on far flaps, offsetting the flaps a bit so all four legs show.



13 IRF tail + neck a.f.a.p.



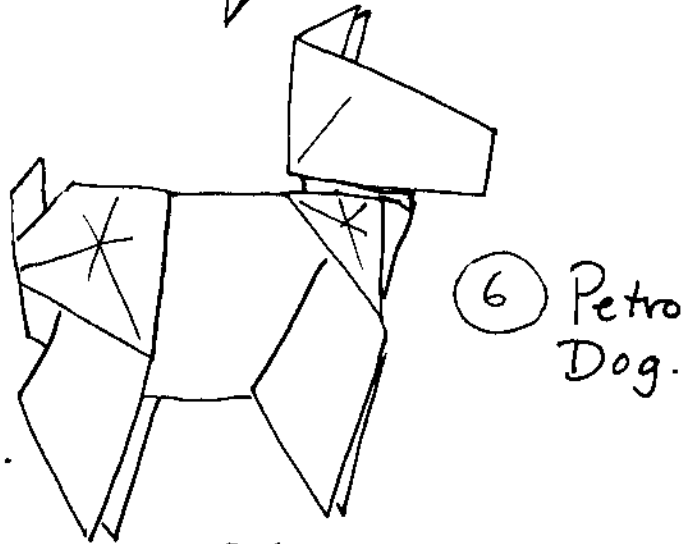
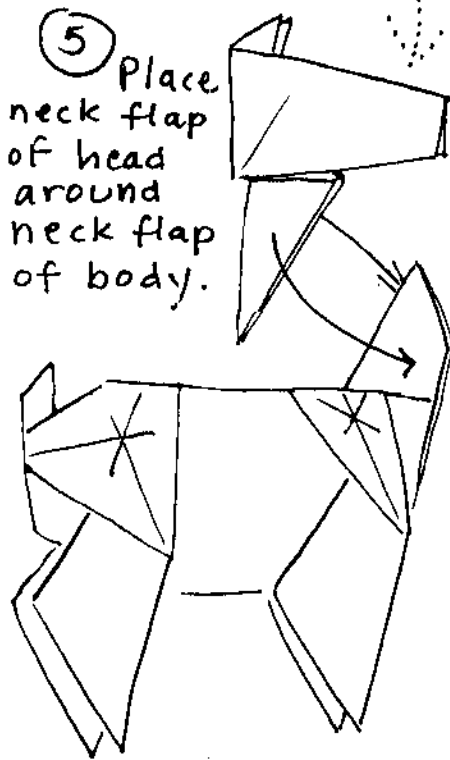
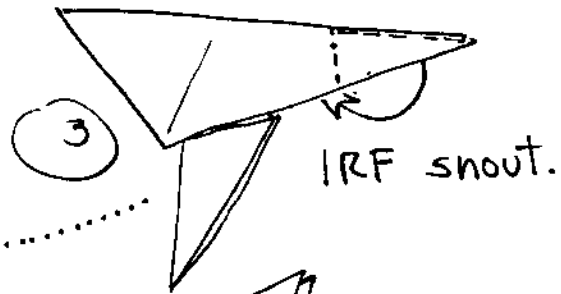
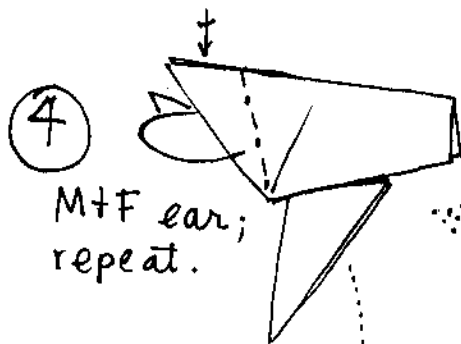
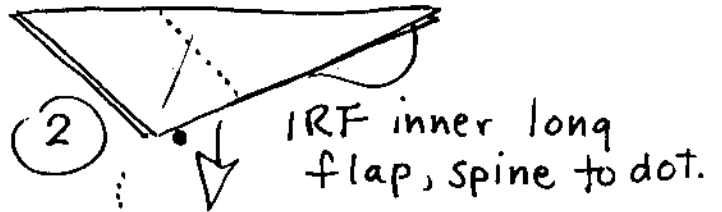
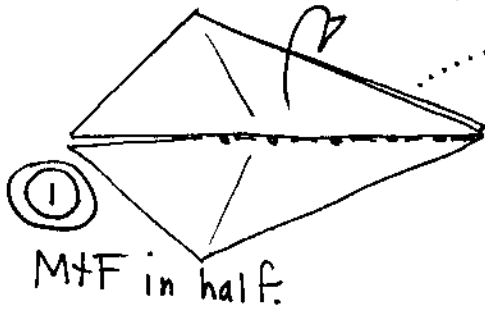
14 (a) Narrow tail w/ MTFs;
