




PETRO Dog





(a) Pinch the half on the right side of the paper;






- 9 Holding paper down at circle, VF at 1. with a triangular spread squash at 2. (Note - thick part of paper is on the left.)





- 10 VF near flap on the right.




- 11 Holding paper down at circle, spread-squash as in step 9.

 (b) Level off back w/ M+Fs.









- 15 M+Fs to narrow neck (see step 5, next page, for result.)
