




# PETRO LIZARD

or regular Kami.


(Most mono-color paper has a smoother, more finished side. I use that as the "right" or "desired" side.) Use a 3" square for an ATC model.




Begin with a blintzed fish base :


1. Wrong side up, FUF books & outer diagonals.
2. Flip and blintz.
3. Flip and fold a fish base.
4. UF corners from underneath.



Rabbit-  
ear each  
upper flap.




VF

flaps.




Rabbit-ear  
each lower flap.




the layers underneath will tug  
open. Squash-fold  
there. Repeat on left.

upper half.

seam and pull a  
single\* layer of  
paper out to  
each side. Flatten.
