

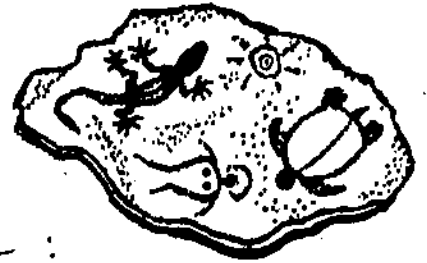

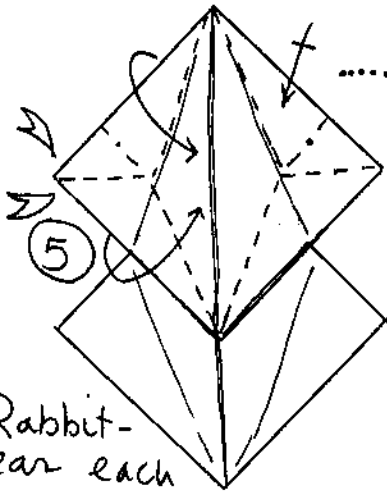
Use thin paper, mono-color or regular Kami.

(Most mono-color paper has a smoother, more finished side. Use that as the "right" or "desired" side.) Use a 3" square for an ATC model.

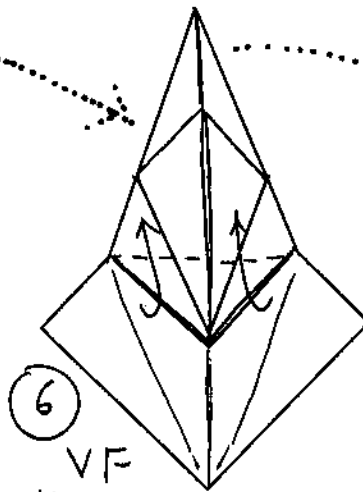


Begin with a blintzed fish base:

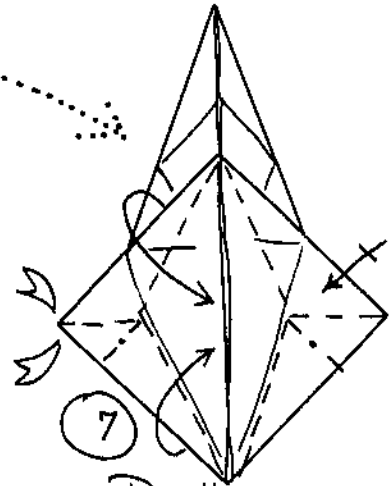
1. Wrong side up, FUF books & outer diagonals.
2. Flip and blintz.
3. Flip and fold a fish base.
4. UF corners from underneath.



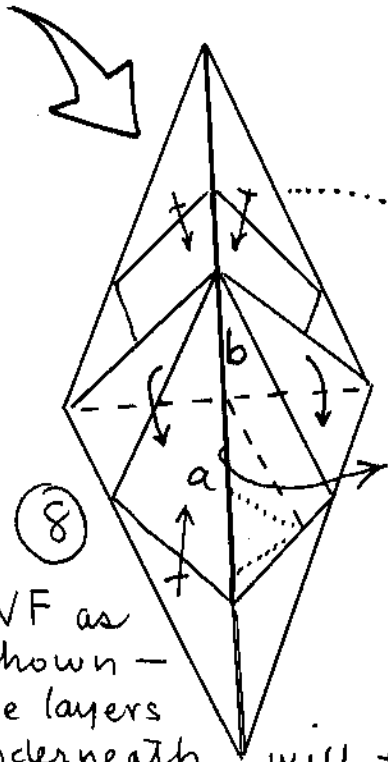
Rabbit-ear each upper flap.



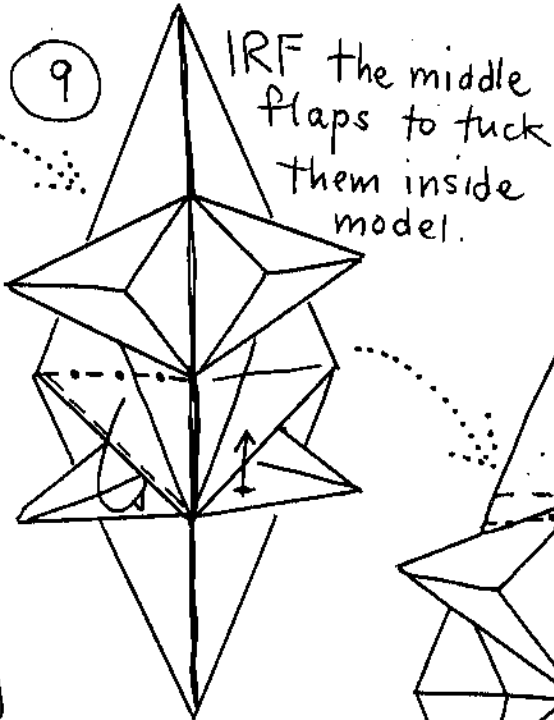
VF these middle flaps.



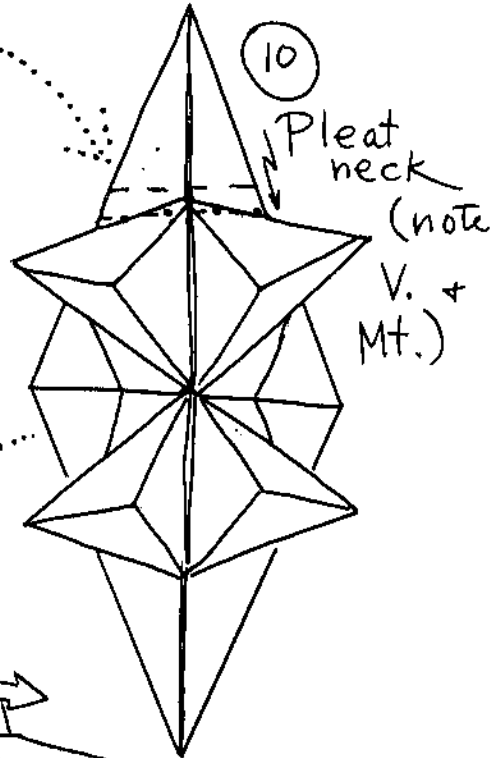
Rabbit-ear each lower flap.



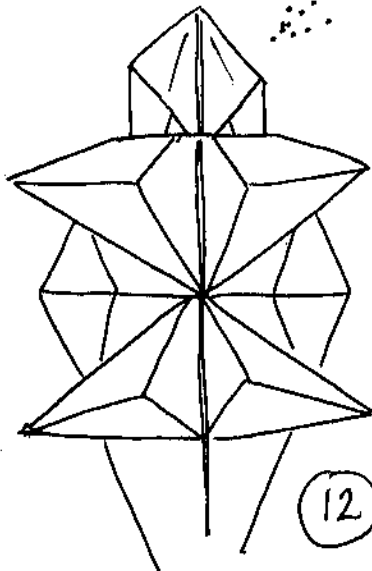

(a) VF as shown - the layers underneath will tug open. Squash-fold there. Repeat on left.  
(b) VF middle flaps down and repeat (a) on upper half.



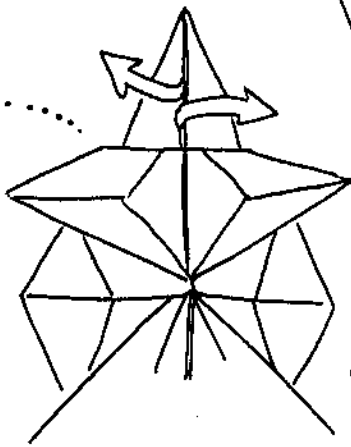
9 IRF the middle flaps to tuck them inside model.



10 Pleat neck (note V. + Mt.)



12 Flip.



11 Open seam and pull a single\* layer of paper out to each side. Flatten.

(\* i.e., the near layer)
