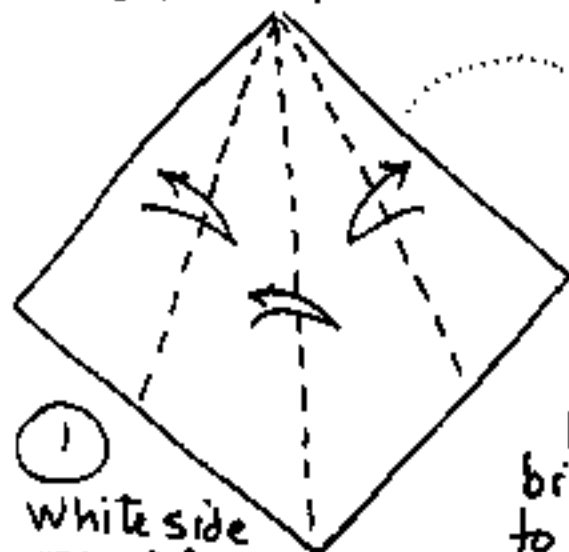
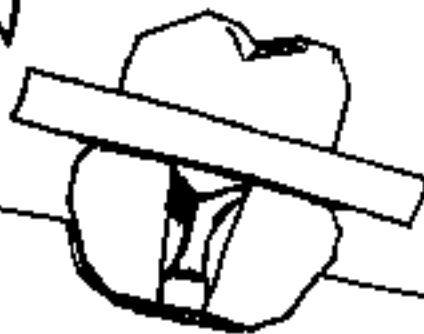

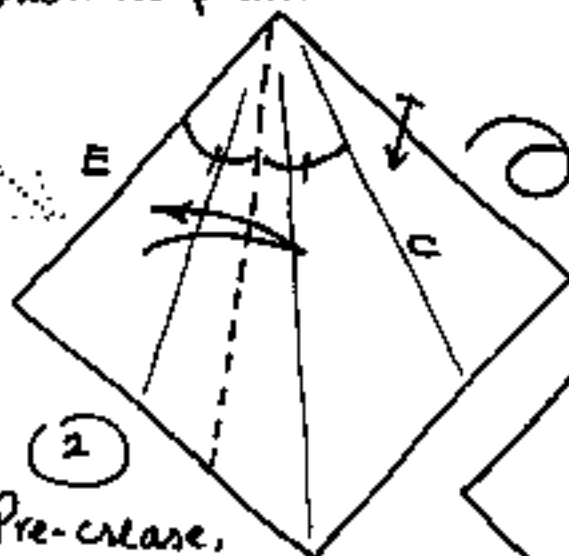

A 10" square of paper yields an 8" tall model (9" tall with added hat.)

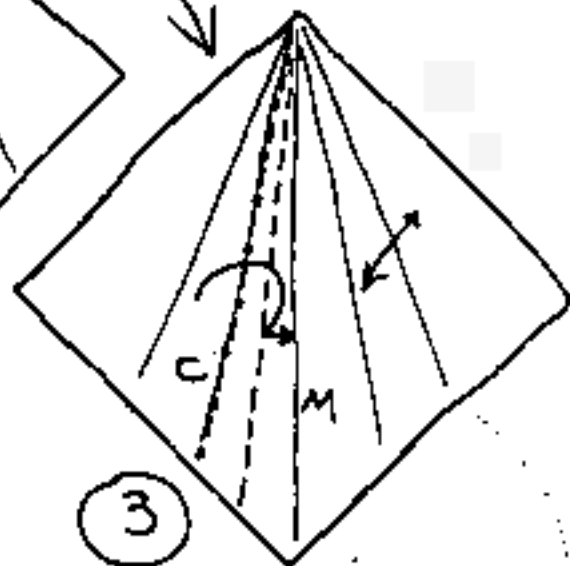
Suggestion: Try a paper with a fabric-like pattern, such as plaid gift wrap.



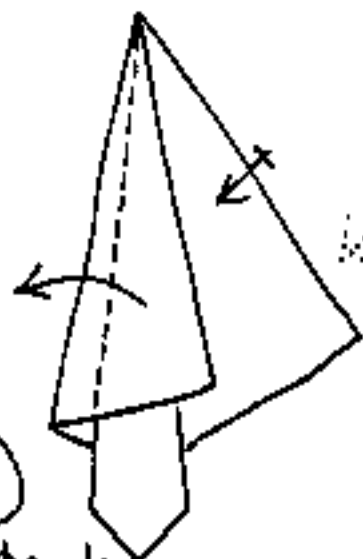
① White side up: a) Pre-crease a diagonal. b) Pre-crease a kite fold.



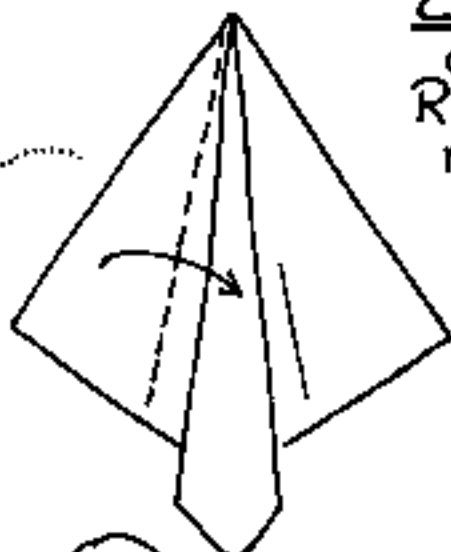
② Pre-crease, bringing edge E to crease C. Repeat opposite, + turn over.



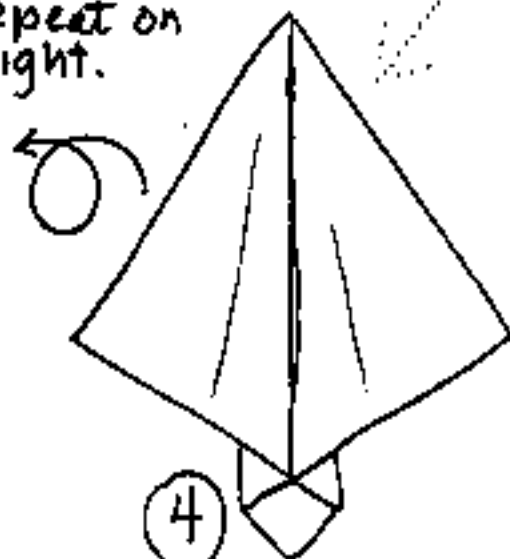
③ Pinch up mountain crease C + pleat so it lies on middle M. Repeat on right.



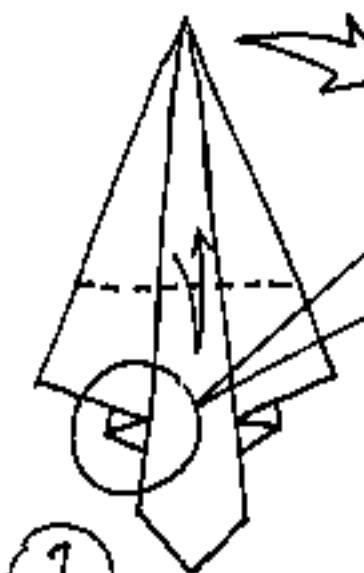
④ Rub the left area so the underlying ridge shows up. VF on the mark so the new edge abuts the existing folded edge. Repeat.



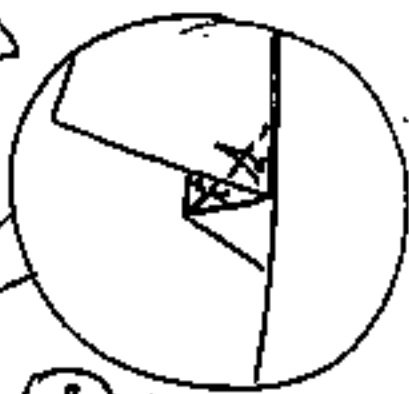
⑤ VF on existing crease.



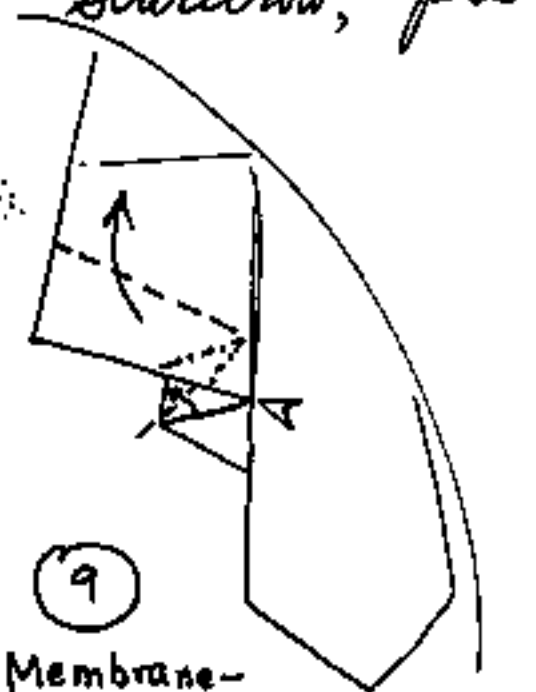
⑥ Flip model over.



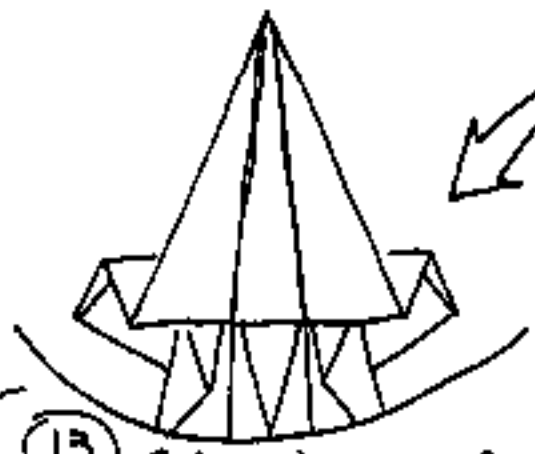
7 VF in half and unfold.



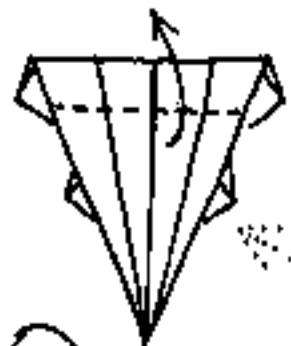
8 Enlarged detail. Pre-crease, bisecting corner.



9 Membrane-fold. Repeat 8 + 9 on right.



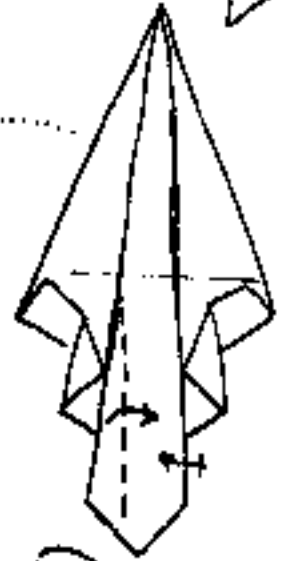
13 Enlarged view of result. TMO.



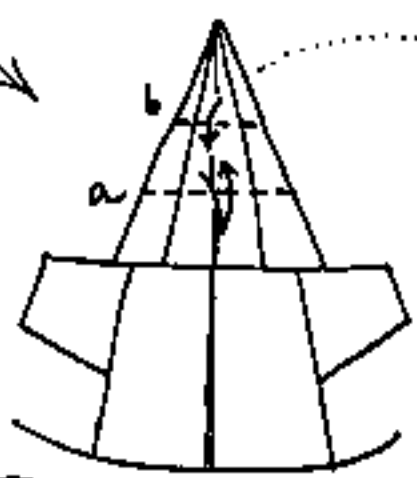
12 VF, just below widest part of model.



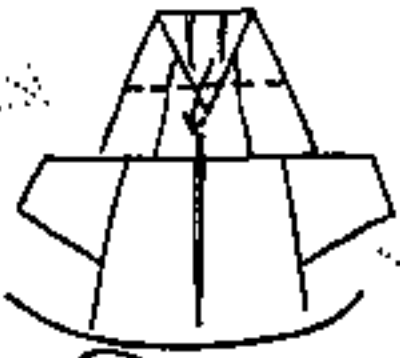
11 Refold in half.



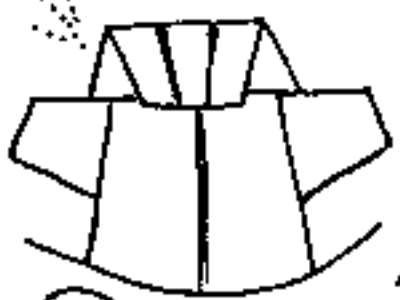
10 VF to narrow (overlap).



14 a) Pre-crease. b) VF so tip is past crease.

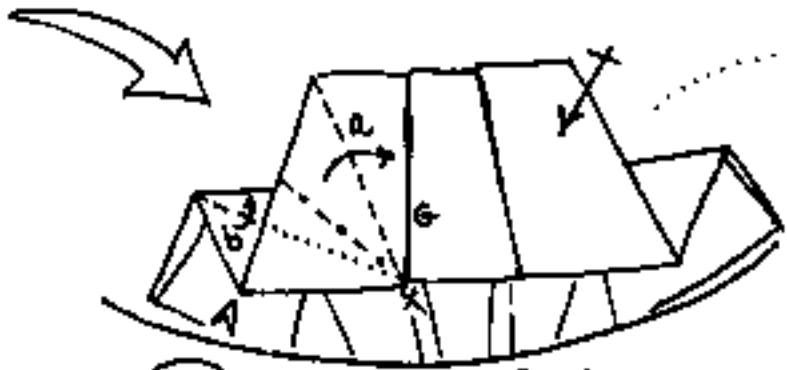

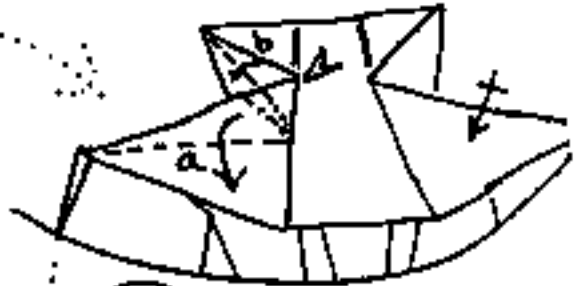

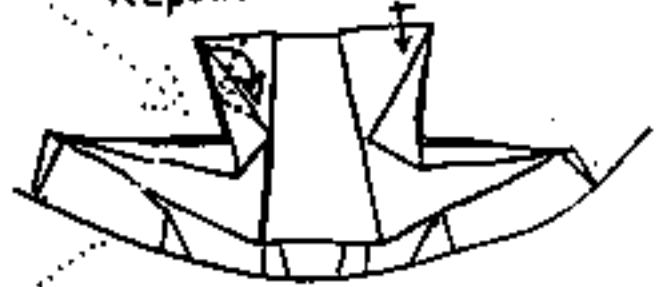


17 Membrane-fold:

b) VF - not bisecting corner -

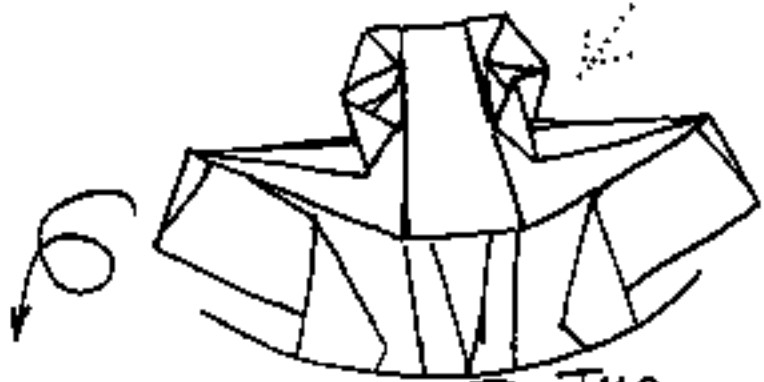
Note X - folds converge at the gully (G) of the pleat.



18 Another membrane fold; Repeat.



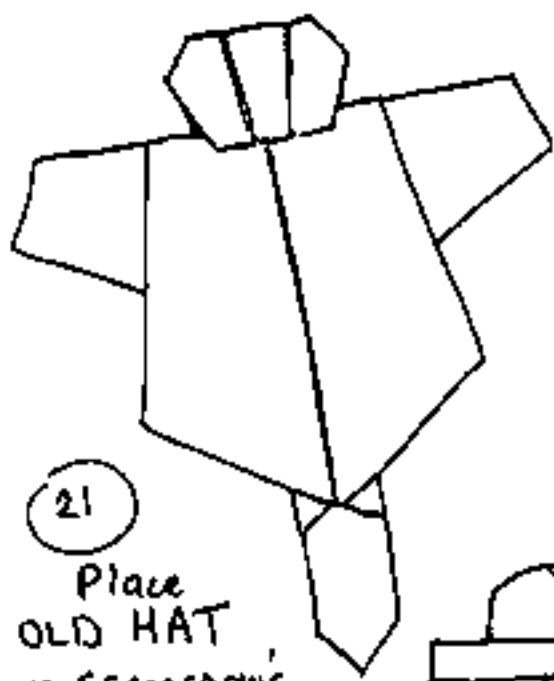
19 IRF corner; Repeat.

VARIATIONS:

- 1) It is possible to color-change the stake.
- 2) Pinch up the middle pleat of the head to create a face (see p. 1). Round off jawline.
- 3) Tilt the head by changing the angle of the valley fold in step 14a - 15.
