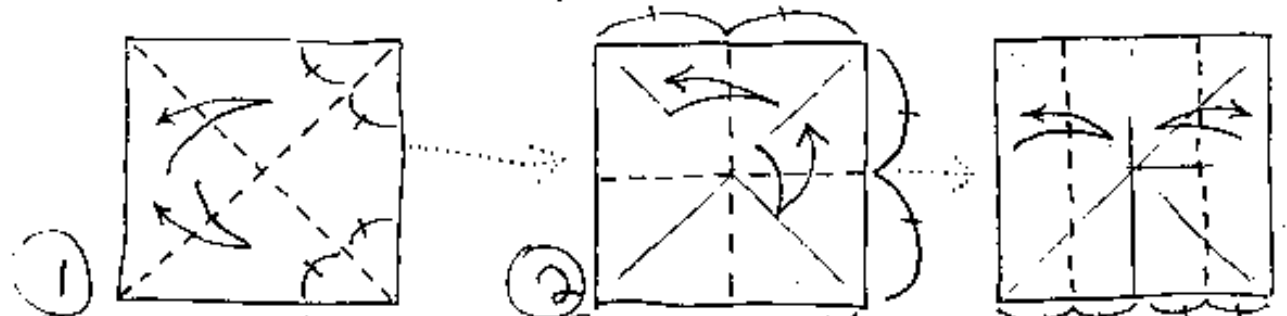


SHAMROCK

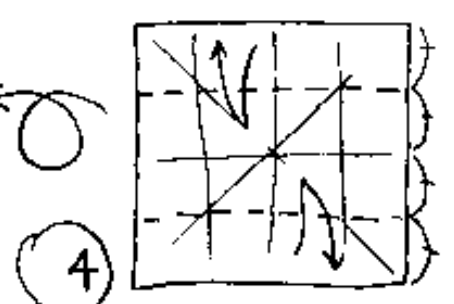
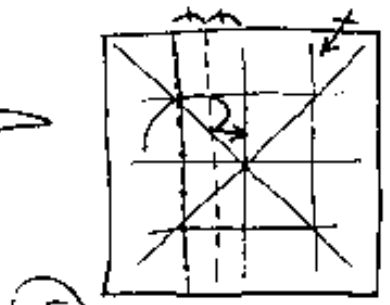
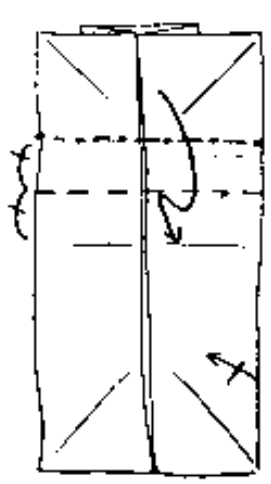
Use a square of green paper. Start white side up. A 6" (15 cm) square will yield a 3½" (9 cm) wide shamrock.



1 Pre-crease the paper in half, along each diagonal.

2 Pre-crease the paper in half, parallel to the edges.

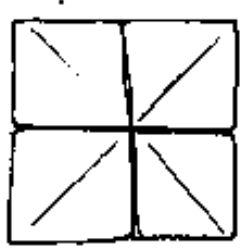
3 Pre-crease each vertical edge to the middle line.



5 Notice that all creases are mountains on this side. Pinch up one of step 3's creases and fold it over to meet the middle line. Repeat with the other one.

4 Pre-crease each horizontal edge to the middle line, and flip paper over.

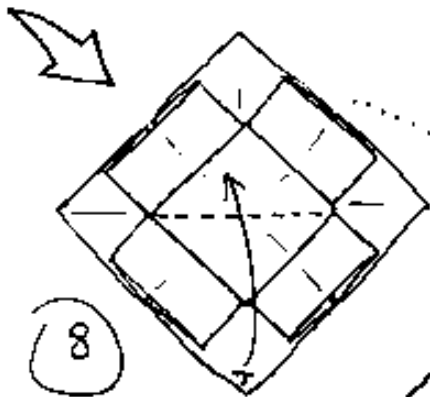
6 Pinch up one of step 4's creases and fold it down to meet the middle line. Repeat with the other one.



7 Flip the paper over, also shifting its position.

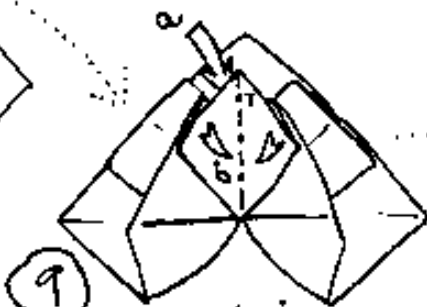

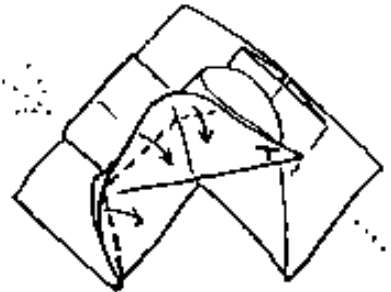

VF lower half up on the middle part of the horizon. (Follow the T [tip].)



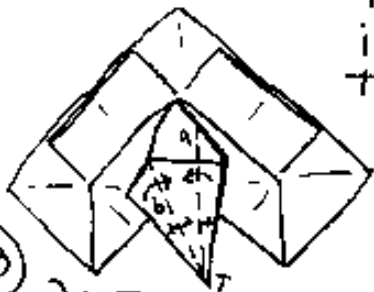

Flatten.



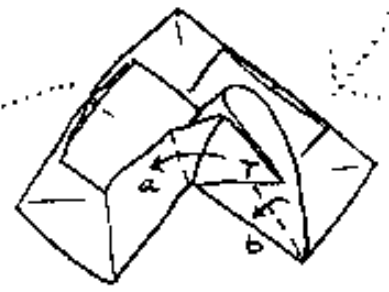

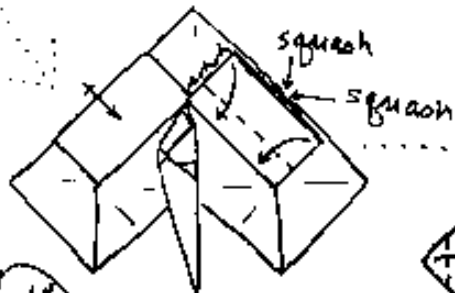
VF, centering tip (T) in space between leaflets.

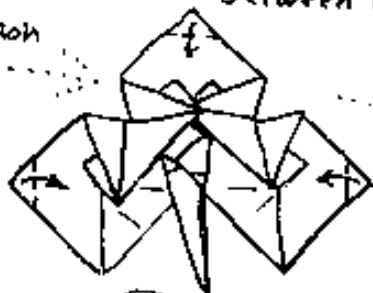
a) VF flap to left.

b) Flatten paper as in step 10.



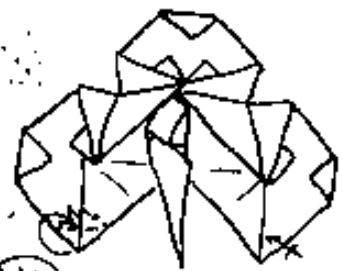

VF, squashing these hidden corners. Repeat on left.



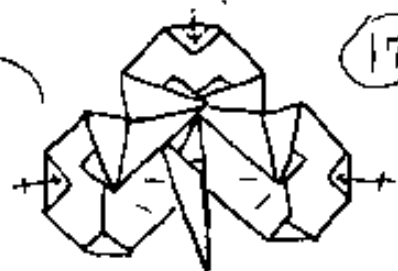
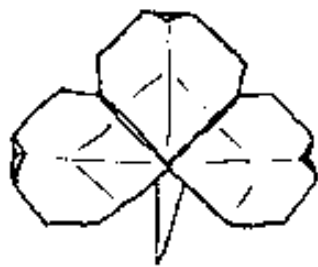

VF outer corners.



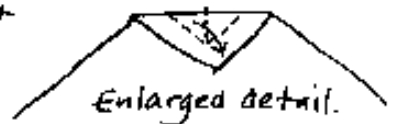
