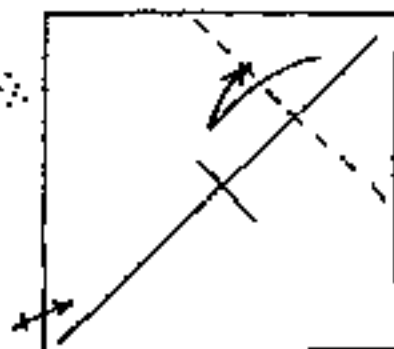
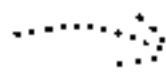
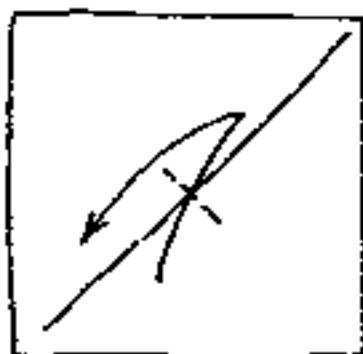


TWIN-SCALLOP ORNAMENT

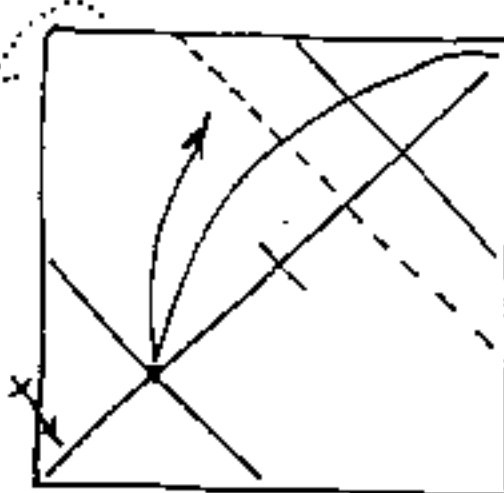
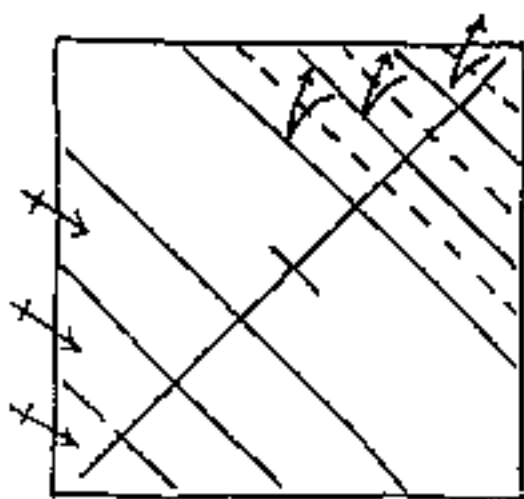

① Square, colored side up. Pre-crease one diagonal. Turn over.

② Pinch a little crease along the other diagonal, to mark the center.

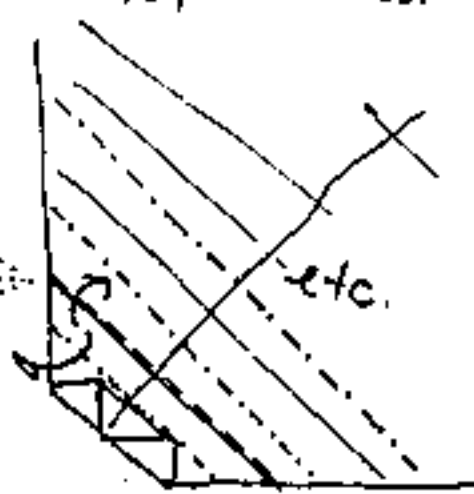
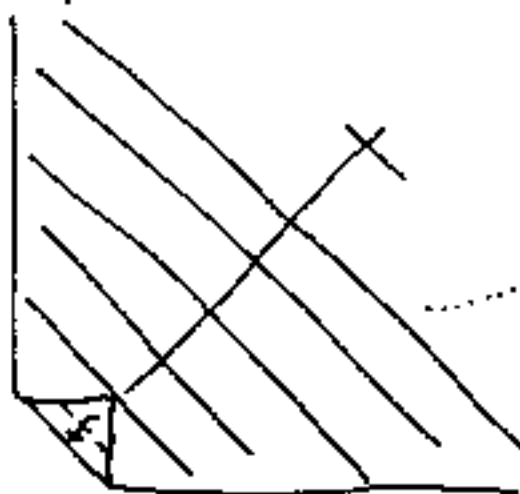
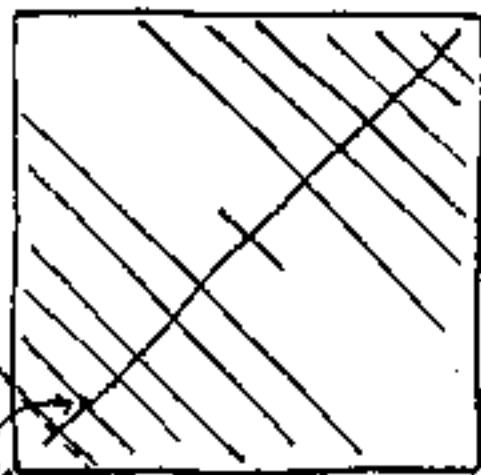
③ Pre-crease, bringing a corner to the center across the diagonal. Repeat w/ opp. corner.



④ Pre-crease to bisect each of the 6 sections.

⑤ Pre-crease corner to near crease made in step 3. Repeat across.

⑥ Pre-crease corner to opp. crease made in step 3. Repeat across.

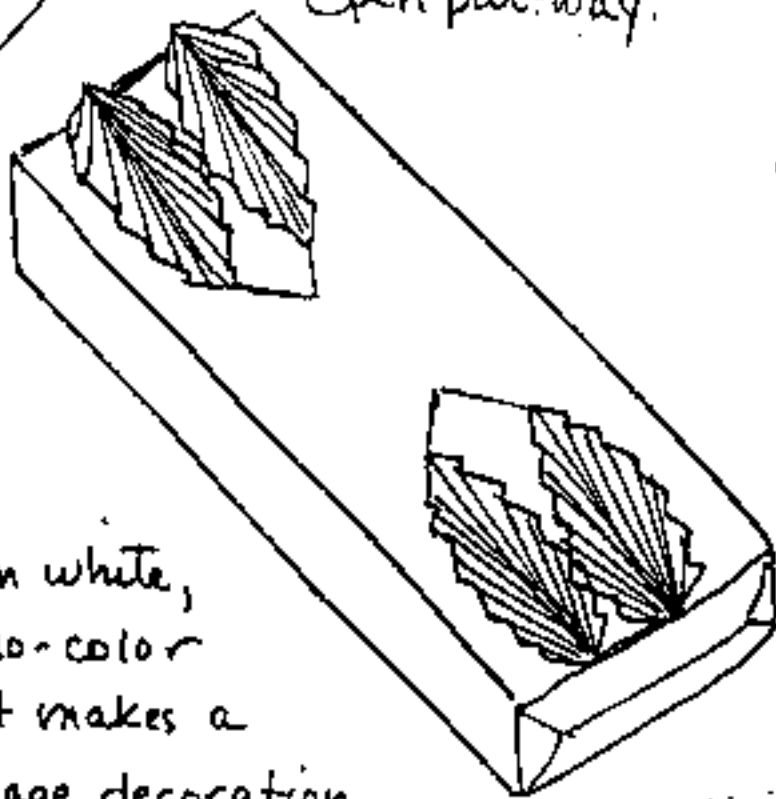
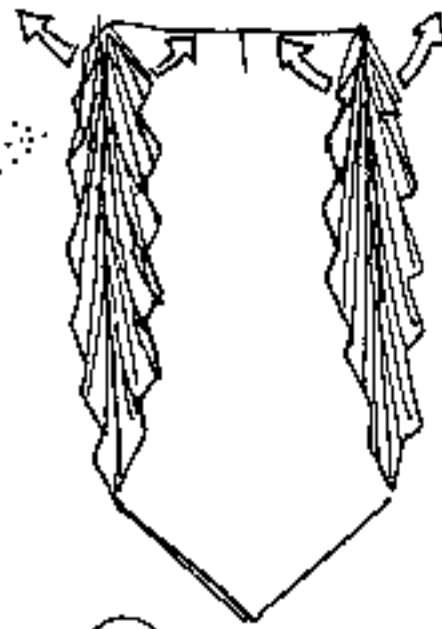
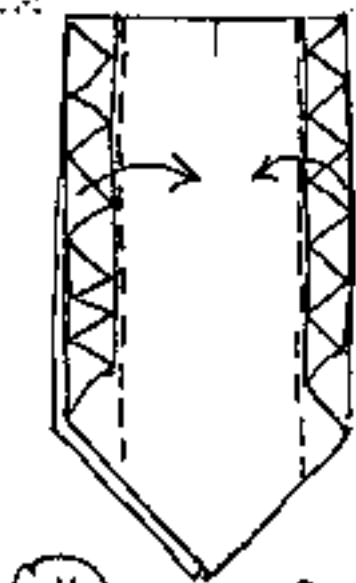
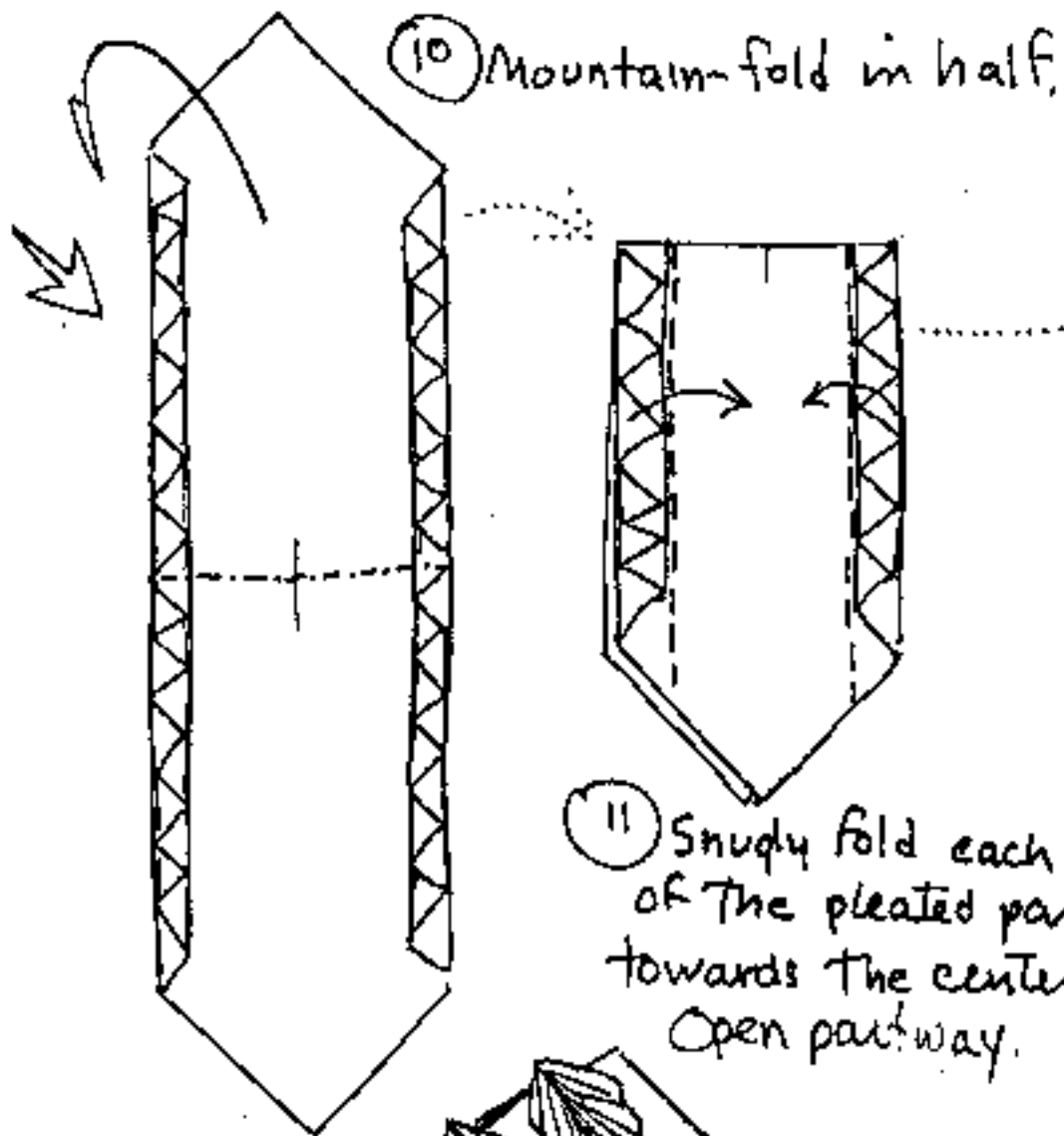


⑦ Fold tiny corner on its crease to the nearest crease.

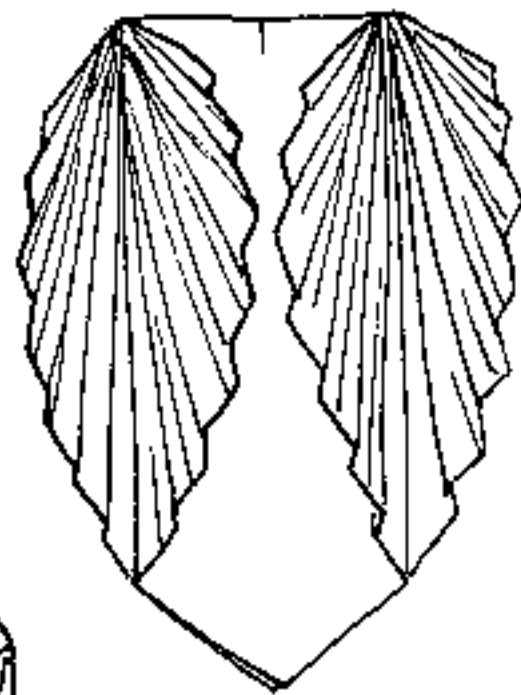
⑧ Detail: fold tip back, bisecting section.

⑨ Repeat with each of the other narrow sections, pleating both halves of the paper.

(Leave wide middle section unfolded)



Made in white, or from duo-color paper, it makes a nice package decoration.



This is the basic design.

Variations are possible:

- a. fold lower near tip back up at start of shells.
- b. Mt. fold model down the middle, rotate + stand it up for a table decoration.

- c. pinch the flat part back out of sight.
- d. fold the shells back-to-back + secure with locking folds.
