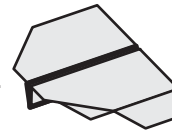


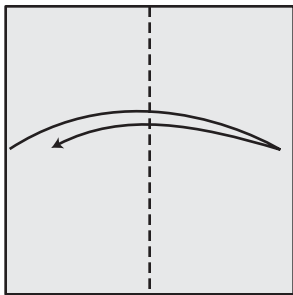
# FINNY FREESTYLE FLIER (3F) (2000)

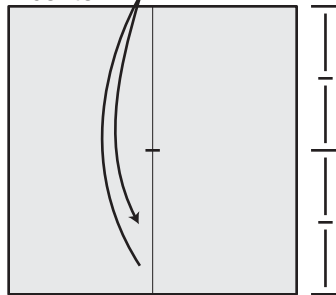
This little gem is a nimble little stunt plane. It can be flown inside, or outside equally well. Models can be folded from pieces as small as 1.25 to 2 inch, and will still fly quite well. Start Color side up.



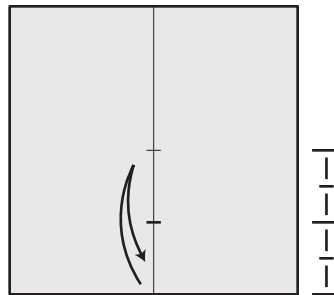
1.) Fold in half, unfold



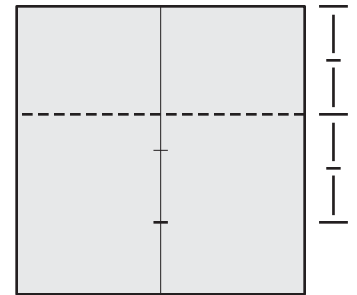
2.) Pinch fold to find the center



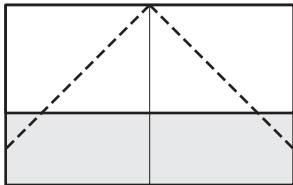
3.) Pinch fold to find the 1/4 mark.



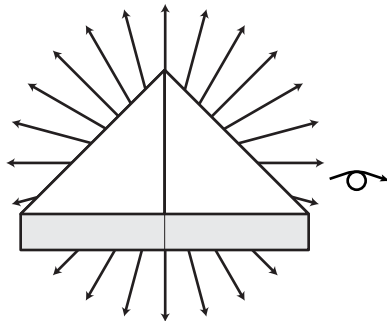
4.) Fold the top edge down to meet the 1/4 mark.



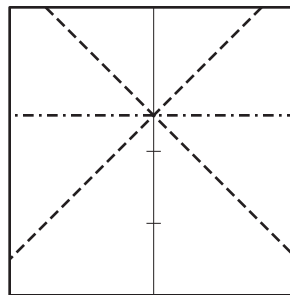
5.) Fold the corners into the centerline.



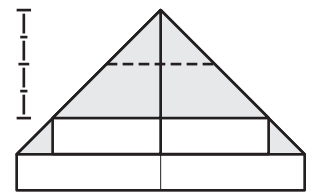
6.) Unfold completely.



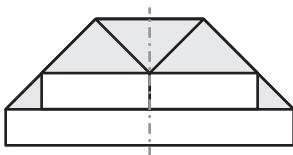
7.) Refold along the existing creases, to fold an off center waterbomb base.



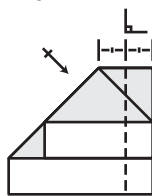
8.) Fold the tip back to the raw edge.



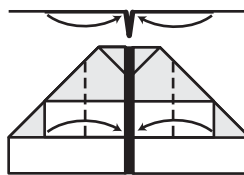
9.) Fold in half.



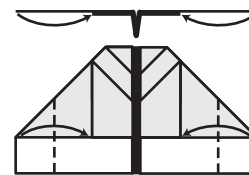
10.) Fold the wing down halfway from the leading edge to the center. Repeat behind.



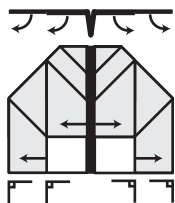
11.) Fold the inner edges to meet at the center.



12.) This is the same as step 11. Fold the tips to the new edge.

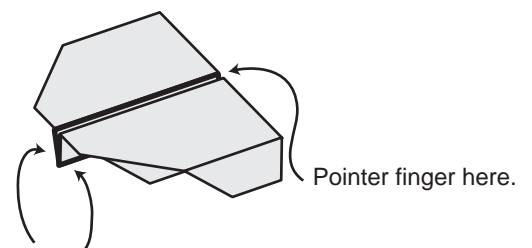


13.) Unfold the fins down to form right edges.



14.) The fun part! Hold the plane as indicated. When you throw it, push off from the back. You can also toss it sideways. Or you can Knuckle Toss it.

What's a Knuckle Toss you might ask! Hold the center of the plane, with the leading edge pointed up, with your knuckles. Sewing your lower arm upward and release when your arm is parallel to the ground. If done right, the plane will loop right back to you. This is a great "Stealth" toss, as it doesn't look like you are going to toss it, until you do.
